## Elections Office celebrates National Voter Registration Day

---



The San Bernardino County Elections Office is celebrating National Voter Registration Day on Tuesday, Sept. 26 by encouraging people to register to vote.

National Voter Registration Day was established in 2012 in response to more than 6 million Americans reporting that they didn't vote as a result of missing the registration deadline or not knowing how to register. It has now become an annual celebration as thousands of people ensure their family, friends and neighbors are registered to vote.

To mark this event, the Elections Office has partnered with Hot 103.9, which will promote National Voter Registration Day live on the radio. Additionally, the Elections Office will visit the following locations on Tuesday and encourage eligible citizens to register to vote:

Voters may also obtain a paper voter registration application in-person at city clerk offices and libraries throughout the county, or at the Elections Office, 777 East Rialto Ave., San Bernardino. Additionally, applications are distributed by more than 80 governmental agencies in San Bernardino County.

"Our office actively works to make voter registration applications as accessible and as convenient as possible for voters in San Bernardino County," said Michael Scarpello, Registrar of Voters. "In addition, we have improved our My Elections (M.E.) Gateway application so voters can easily access additional personalized voter information."
