**Special Primary Election State Senate District 23
Candidate Filing Begins at San Bernardino County Elections Office**

On December 5, 2013, Governor Jerry Brown signed a proclamation calling for a special election in State Senate District 23 to fill a vacancy which occurred after former Senator Bill Emmerson resigned his seat.

The Secretary of State's Office has set the Special Primary Election date for March 25, 2014. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes, the top two candidates from the Primary will face a runoff during the 2014 Statewide Primary Election to be held on June 3.

For residents in San Bernardino County, candidate filings for this office will be taken at the San Bernardino County Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters located at 777 East Rialto Ave. in San Bernardino. The first day for filing is Saturday, January 11, 2014 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The filing period will continue Monday, January 13 through Friday, January 31 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

State Senate District 23 is shared by San Bernardino, Riverside, and Los Angeles counties. Approximately 299,000 voters reside in San Bernardino County, 143,000 voters reside in Riverside County, and 30 voters reside in Los Angeles County.
