NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that 5 p.m. on July 24, 2020, is the last day and hour that rebuttals to the arguments for or against the measure may be filed by mail, email, fax or in person with the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words in length and shall be accompanied by the statement set forth in Section 9600 of the Elections Code. NOTICE IS ALSO FURTHER GIVEN that upon approval of the formation of the Spring Valley Lake Community Services District, this election shall also include the election of a five-member Board of Directors.

The qualifications required to be a candidate for the above office is:

A candidate must be a registered voter residing within the proposed district at the time nomination documents are issued.

Official nomination documents for eligible candidates desiring to file for the above elective office may be obtained from the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters, 777 E. Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, California, starting on July 13, 2020, and filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2020, at the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters.
