To whom it may concern,

As a longtime resident of Joshua Tree I am writing to ask that a polling place for the November election be made available to residents here in Joshua Tree, without having to go to the next town to vote.

Sunburst Park has always worked very well for local residents. I understand that this location will be open for early voting but then is not available on Election Day?

This seems especially arbitrary, confusing and inconsistent.

I can imagine no reason why, in this upcoming election, which is already fraught with potential problems, including outside interference, our county officials would not be doing everything within their power to ensure a good turn out by the voters who wish to participate in our Democracy.

The following are recommended as possible polling places in Joshua Tree:

- Lutheran Church of the Desert - 6336 Hallee Rd - which has been used as a polling place in the past
- Way Station - 61722 Commercial St - this would be an excellent location for reaching marginalized, unhoused residents

Joshua Tree has several more churches, as well as outdoor places such as the patio of the Joshua Tree Saloon, the Station, the Art Queen complex.

Thank you in advance for helping to make sure our right to vote without any additional hardship is not impeded in any way.
