DO YOU SPEAK ENGLISH AND SPANISH?

Make extra cash, do your civic duty and help fellow voters with your language skills.

The San Bernardino County Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters is seeking bilingual poll workers for the November 6, 2012 General Election.

Poll workers who speak English and Spanish earn additional pay for their work.

“San Bernardino County has a high volume of Spanish-speaking citizens,” said Registrar Michael J. Scarpello. “We want to provide customer service and assist those voters in the language they speak to help them feel comfortable in the voting process.”

Poll workers are required to:

1. Be 18 years or older and a registered voter in the State of California, or
2. Be a high school student at least 16 years old and in good academic standing.
3. Read and write English.
4. Attend a mandatory two-hour training session.

Poll workers work from 6 a.m. until approximately 9 p.m. Clerks are paid \$115 for working Election Day and must attend a training class. Supervisors are paid \$180 plus mileage for working Election Day and must attend two training classes.

Bilingual workers fluent in both English and Spanish make an additional \$10.
