**Last Day to Register to Vote is October 22**

The deadline for San Bernardino County voters to register to vote is Monday, October 22, 2012 for the upcoming Presidential General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2012.

Citizens may register to vote online on the Secretary of State's website at [registertovote.ca.gov](http://registertovote.ca.gov).

Registration forms are also available throughout San Bernardino County at post offices, libraries, offices of city clerks and the Department of Motor Vehicles. A full list is available at [www.sbcountyelections.com](http://www.sbcountyelections.com).

To register to vote, a person must be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A person not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony
- At least 18 years old on Election Day

Voters who have moved to San Bernardino County must re-register to vote. Voters who have moved within the County do not need to re-register. However, they need to update their address with the San Bernardino County Elections Office by filling out an in-County change of address form at [www.sbcountyelections.com](http://www.sbcountyelections.com).

Voters may also mail a letter with their name, new address, old address, date of birth and signature to the Elections Office, 777 East Rialto Ave., San Bernardino, CA 92415.
