Early Voting Locations Extend into Weekend for the 2014 Statewide General Election



Early voting locations will be open this weekend to offer additional early voting opportunities for the November 4, 2014 Statewide General Election. San Bernardino County voters can cast their votes at the San Bernardino County Elections Office and the Montclair Branch Library on Saturday and at the Hesperia Branch Library on both Saturday and Sunday.

“Our goal is to make voting more convenient for registered voters, and one way we can do this is to provide early voting over the weekend,” said Michael J. Scarpello, Registrar of Voters. “Hopefully, those people who are not able to make it to the polls on Tuesday will take advantage of this opportunity.”

There are 851,684 voters in San Bernardino County who are eligible to vote in Tuesday’s election. Voters can find their assigned polling place on the back of their Voter Information Guide, online at www.sbcouneyelections.com, or by calling the Elections Office at (800) 881-VOTE or (909) 387-8300.

For vote by mail voters, mail ballots must arrive at the Elections Office no later than 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 4. A mail ballot postmarked on Election Day, but not received at the Elections Office by 8 p.m., will not be counted. Mail ballots can also be returned during normal business hours to any County library, any City Clerks’ office, or the Elections Office in San Bernardino. A map of those locations is available on the Elections Office website at www.sbcouneyelections.com. Mail ballots can also be returned to any Election Day polling place.

The San Bernardino County Elections Office, located at 777 East Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, CA 92415, will be open to voters on Saturday, November 1, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Montclair Branch Library, located at 9955 Fremont Avenue, Montclair, CA 91763, will be open to voters on Saturday, November 1, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Hesperia Branch Library, located at 9650 7th Avenue, Hesperia, CA 92345, will be open to voters on Saturday, November 1, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Sunday, November 2, from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.
