Mail Ballot Drop-off Locations August 31, 2021 Consolidated Mail Ballot Election

For the August 31, 2021 Consolidated Mail Ballot Election, the Registrar will provide mail ballot drop-off locations for the public to securely return their mail ballots. Each location has been surveyed and determined to be accessible to voters with disabilities. Voters using a drop-off location must deliver their ballot no later than 8 p.m. on Election Night.

The following secure, outdoor Mail Ballot Drop Boxes will be open beginning no later than Tuesday, August 3, 2021. Unless otherwise noted, drop boxes are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week until each is locked at 8 p.m. on Tuesday, August 31, 2021.
